JUDGMENT

The Employment Tribunal determines as follows:

- 1. The respondent failed to consult with the employees' representatives in breach of its obligations under s188 Trade Union & Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992.
- 2. The Tribunal awards a protective award of a sum equivalent to 90-days pay to any employee of the respondent as of 23 April 2020 who was

dismissed by reason of redundancy.
