JUDGMENT

The complaints of "Bullying and Harassment" and "Redundancy Payment" are struck out.

REASONS

- 1. By a letter dated **17 September 2020** the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to make representations as to why the complaints of Bullying and Harassment and Redundancy Payment should not be struck out because they
 - did not identify any potential characteristic on which the Claimant relies,
 - the dates or approximate dates when the alleged acts occurred,
 - did not explain why the Claimant claims to be entitled to a Redundancy Payment when he was in his own case dismissed for alleged gross misconduct.
- 2. The claimant has failed to make representations in writing, or has failed to make any sufficient representations, why this should not be done or to request a hearing. The complaints of Bullying and Harassment and Redundancy Payment are therefore struck out.
- 3. The claimant's remaining claims remains listed for hearing on 28 April 2021.
