JUDGMENT

The Judgment of the Tribunal is that:

 The claimant's complaints of unlawful discrimination because of the protected characteristic of her disability in breach of section 13,15, 19, 20 & 21 and 26 of the Equality Act 2010 do not succeed and are dismissed.

Case Number 1309493/2020

- The Employment Tribunal does not have jurisdiction to entertain complaints in relation complaints about acts occurring on or before the 7 May 2020.
- The claimant's complaint that she was subject to unlawful detriment in breach of section 48 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 do not succeed and are dismissed
- 4. The claimant's complaint that she was subject to an Automatically Unfair dismissal having made a health and safety complaint do not succeed and are dismissed.
