JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out.

REASONS

- 1. The claimant did not have the necessary two-year qualifying period of service at the date of dismissal, as required by section 108 Employment Rights Act 1996 and so a complaint of unfair dismissal has no reasonable prospect of success.
- 2. His application to amend the claim to one of automatically unfair dismissal under section 103A Employment Rights Act 1996 (for making a protected disclosure) was dismissed on the basis that:
 - a. he cannot rely on protection from the fact that other people made disclosures;
 - b. he has not alleged that any disclosure was the principal reason for his dismissal; and
 - c. the balance of prejudice was against allowing the application, applying the factors in **Selkent Bus Company v Moore 1996 ICR 836**, particularly the application of time limits and the fact that it was reasonably practicable for him to have made such a complaint in time.
