JUDGMENT

- 1. The claim for compensation related to entitlement to leave pursuant to Regulations 13, 13A, 14 & 30 Working Time Regulations 1998 succeeds.
- 2. The Respondent is ordered to pay to the Claimant the sum of £3,171.01 in respect of holiday pay.
- 3. Pursuant to s 38 Employment Act 2002 the Respondent is ordered to pay to the Claimant a sum equivalent to 2 weeks' pay, being £954.
- 4. The total to be paid by the Respondent to the Claimant is £4,125.01.
