## **JUDGMENT**

- 1. The Claimant's claim for unlawful deduction from wages is well founded.
- 2. The Claimant was not paid £2,595 for work undertaken between 16<sup>th</sup> October 2021 and 31<sup>st</sup> December 2021. However, the Respondent was entitled to deduct from that sum £1,186.39 as an authorised deduction under section 13(1)(b) of the Employment Rights Act 1996.
- 3. The Respondent shall therefore pay the Claimant the net sum of £1,408.61 in respect of the unlawful deductions from wages.
