JUDGMENT

The claims of disability discrimination, no notice pay, unauthorised deduction of wages and “other payments” are dismissed on non-appearance of the claimant.

REASONS

1. The case was listed for hearing at Leeds Employment Tribunal at 10.00am on 1 February 2022 but was subsequently converted to a CVP on the same date.
2. By 10.00am the claimant did not come on the video nor had the Tribunal had any communication from him. The respondent did not attend, having failed in any event to file a response.
3. At 10.00am the clerk called the claimant’s telephone which first rang engaged and then failed.

4. Once the clerk failed to get through on the claimant's telephone, the clerk sent an email to the claimant. The Tribunal allowed a quarter of an hour for the claimant to reply.
5. At 10.30am the clerk attempted to call the claimant again but without success.
6. In all the circumstances the Tribunal dismissed the claimant's claims.
