Statement on behalf of the Senior President of Tribunals

This has been a remote hearing that has not objected to by the parties. A face to face hearing was not held because it was not practicable and all issues could be determined in a remote hearing. The documents that I was referred to are in a bundle of over 200 pages, the contents of which I have recorded.

JUDGMENT

- 1 The respondent has unfairly and wrongfully dismissed the claimant.
- The respondent is ordered to pay the claimant three weeks net wages for breach of contract in the sum of £1,130.67.
- The respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the following sums in respect of the claimant's unfair dismissal, to which I find he contributed to the extent of 50%:-
- 3.1 A basic award in the sum of £1,125.00.
- 3.2 A compensatory award in the sum of £6,611.80.
- 4 The recoupment regulations apply to the above awards. For that purpose:-
- 4.1 The total award is in the sum of £8,867.47
- 4.2 The prescribed period is from 30 September 2020 to 5 May 2021.
- 4.3 The prescribed sum is £6,611.80.
- 5 The total award exceeds the prescribed sum by £2,255.67
