JUDGMENT

- 1. The claimant's complaint of wrongful dismissal (notice pay) is dismissed on withdrawal.
- 2. The claimant's complaint of non-payment/part payment of a redundancy payment is dismissed on withdrawal.
- 3. The claimant's complaint of non-payment of holiday pay is dismissed on withdrawal.
- 4. The claimant's complaint of unfair dismissal is well-founded and the tribunal awards the claimant £ 676.92. The recoupment regulations do not apply to this sum.
- 5. The claimant's complaint of an unlawful deduction from wages is not well-founded and is dismissed.
