JUDGMENT

- The claimant had not been continuously employed by the respondent for a period of not less than two years at the effective date of termination of her employment as required by section 108 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 ("ERA") in order to bring a claim of "standard" unfair dismissal under section 94 ERA.
- 2. In these circumstances, the Tribunal has no jurisdiction to consider the claimant's claim for "standard" unfair dismissal which is therefore dismissed.
