- 1. The Claimant's form ET1 is amended so that the date on which the Claimant's employment ended is stated in part 5.1 to be 25 June 2021.
- The Claimant's claim to unauthorised deduction of wages in contravention of section 13 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 is out of time and is dismissed.
- The Claimant's claim to a redundancy payment under Part IX of the Employment Rights Act 1996 is well-founded and is upheld.
- 4. The Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant the sum of £7,125.00.
