## **CONSENT ORDER**

AND BY CONSENT, it is ordered that:-

- 1. The Appeal is allowed;
- 2. The Information Commissioner's Decision Notice dated 1 December 2021 is substituted to the effect that the Appellant is additionally entitled to withhold the following material pursuant to section 37(1)(b) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000:
  - a. The fourth paragraph of the Guidance; and

- b. The third and fourth sentences of the fourth paragraph and the third and fourth sentences of the fifth paragraph of the Briefing Note.
- 3. Further and in the alternative, the Appellant is entitled to withhold the third sentence of the fifth paragraph of the Briefing Note and the first sentence of paragraph 4 of the Guidance pursuant to section 21 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.
- 4. There be no order as to costs.
- 5. Any failure to abide by the terms of the Tribunal's substituted decision notice may amount to a contempt which may, on application, be certified to the Upper Tribunal.
