

Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) Decision notice

Date: 18 May 2018

Public Authority: London Borough of Hackney

Decision (including any steps ordered)

- 1. The complainant made a request for information on 17 January 2018.
- 2. The Commissioner's decision is that the London Borough of Hackney ("the London Borough") failed to respond to the request within 20 working days and has therefore breached Section 10 of the Freedom of Information Act.
- 3. The Commissioner requires the London Borough to take the following steps to ensure compliance with the legislation.
 - Issue a substantive response, under the FOIA, to request number FOI18-0117-18426.
- 4. The London Borough must take these steps within 35 calendar days of the date of this decision notice. Failure to comply may result in the Commissioner making written certification of this fact to the High Court pursuant to section 54 of the FOIA and may be dealt with as a contempt of court.



Request and response

- 5. On 17 January 2018, the complainant submitted a request for information to the London Borough, via an online portal. As such, the complainant does not have an original copy of the request.
- 6. The London Borough acknowledged the request on 17 January 2018 saying:
 - "Thank you for submitting a Freedom of Information request. Your reference number is FOI18-0117-18426.
 - "Your request will be responded to within 20 working days."
- 7. The London Borough had failed to provide a substantive response by the date of this notice.

Scope of the case

- 8. The complainant contacted the Commissioner on 12 April 2018 to complain about the failure, by the London Borough, to respond to his request.
- 9. In line with her usual practice, the Commissioner contacted the London Borough on 18 April 2018 to highlight the outstanding response. She requested that the London Borough respond to the request within 10 working days. The correspondence was eventually acknowledged on 11 May 2018.
- The Complainant contacted the Commissioner on 11 May 2018 to request a decision notice considering the London Borough's compliance with the FOIA.

Reasons for decision

11. Section 1(1) of the FOIA states that:

Any person making a request for information to a public authority is entitled –

(a) to be informed in writing by the public authority whether it holds information of the description specified in the request, and



(b) if that is the case, to have that information communicated to him.

12. Section 8(1) of the FOIA states:

In this Act any reference to a "request for information" is a reference to such a request which –

- (a) is in writing,
- (b) states the name of the applicant and an address for correspondence, and
- (c) describes the information requested.
- 13. The London Borough's response of 17 January 2018 shows that it was handling request FOI18-0117-18426 under the FOIA.
- 14. Section 10 of the FOIA states that responses to requests made under the Act must be provided "promptly and in any event not later than the twentieth working day following the date of receipt."
- 15. From the evidence presented to the Commissioner in this case, it is clear that, in failing to issue a response to the request within 20 working days, the London Borough has breached Section 10 of the FOIA.



Right of appeal

16. Either party has the right to appeal against this decision notice to the First-tier Tribunal (Information Rights). Information about the appeals process may be obtained from:
