This Intervener respectfully submits that the majority judgment of the Federal Supreme Court was correct in holding that the Governor, in acting under the proviso to Section 33(10), was obliged to act only on evidence obtained from proceedings on the floor of the House of Assembly, and that the Governor had exceeded his powers under that Section in acting upon a private communication from a number of members of the House.
