

CHAP. 3.

An Act to empower Committees on Bills confirming or giving A.D. 1871. effect to Provisional Orders to award costs, and examine [28th February 1871.] witnesses on oath.

D E it enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and **D** with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. The Act of the thirty-third and thirty-fourth Victoria, chapter 33 & 34 Vict. one, is hereby repealed.

2. Any Select Committee of either House of Parliament to which Power to any Bill for confirming or giving effect to Provisional Orders has been referred, in relation to any Provisional Order therein contained, may award costs, in like manner and under the same conditions under which costs may be awarded by any Select Committee under Orders to the Act of the twenty-eighth and twenty-ninth Victoria, chapter twenty-seven; and the provisions of the said Act, so far as they are applicable, shall have effect accordingly.

3. Any Select Committee of the House of Commons to which Power to any Bill for confirming or giving effect to Provisional Orders has been referred, in relation to any Provisional Order therein contained, may of Commons examine witnesses upon oath upon any matter relating to such to examine order, and for that purpose may administer an oath to any such oath. witness.

4. For the purpose of this Act, the words "Provisional Order" Interpretashall include provisional certificates, schemes, and orders in the tion of "Provisional nature of Provisional Orders, made under the authority of any Order." statute, and requiring to be confirmed, sanctioned, or carried into effect by Act of Parliament.
