

CHAPTER 9.

An Act to amend the provisions of the Law of A.D. 1929. Property Act, 1925, relating to relief against forfeiture of under-leases. [5th February 1929.]

DE it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty. by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:--

1. Nothing in subsection (8), subsection (9) or sub-Relief of section (10) of section one hundred and forty-six of the under-lessees Law of Property Act, 1925 (which relates to restrictions on and relief against forfeiture of leases and under-leases), shall affect the provisions of subsection (4) of the said 15 Geo. 5. section.

2. This Act may be cited as the Law of Property Short title. (Amendment) Act, 1929, and the Law of Property Act, 1925, the Law of Property (Amendment) Act, 1926, so 16 & 17 far as it amends that Act, and this Act may be cited Geo. 5. c. 11. together as the Law of Property Acts, 1925 to 1929.
