

CHAPTER 3

An Act to increase the number of Marshall scholarships which may be provided in each year.

[17th December, 1959]

BE it enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1.—(1) Section one of the Marshall Aid Commemoration Increase in Act, 1953, shall have effect with the substitution for the reference maximum number of twelve scholarships of a reference to twenty-four or such greater number as Her Majesty may by Order in Council from time to time determine.

- (2) Any Order in Council under this section shall be subject c. 39. to annulment in pursuance of a resolution of either House of Parliament.
- 2. This Act may be cited as the Marshall Scholarships Act, Short title and 1959, and this Act and the Marshall Aid Commemoration Act, construction. 1953, may be cited together as the Marshall Aid Commemoration Acts, 1953 and 1959.
