An Act to amend Part VII of the Licensing Act 1964 in regard to the provision of off-licences in licensing planning areas. [14th July 1967]

Be IT ENACTED by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. Part VII of the Licensing Act 1964 shall not apply to justices' Exclusion of off-licences or to licensed premises for which a justices' off-VII of Licensing Act 1964. 1964 c. 26.

2.—(1) This Act may be cited as the Licensing (Amendment) Short title, Act 1967, and the Licensing Act 1964 and this Act may be cited citation and together as the Licensing Acts 1964 and 1967.

(2) This Act shall come into force at the expiration of the period of one month beginning with the day on which it is passed.
