The Trading with the Enemy (Custodian) (Amendment) Order, 1948

The Board of Trade in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by the Trading with the Enemy Act, 1939(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf do hereby make the following Order:—

- 1. The Orders specified in the Schedule hereto shall henceforth be read and construed as if the following Article were included in each of the said Orders
 - "4A. Any person shall within twenty-eight days after service on him of a notice by the Custodian requiring him so to do furnish to the Custodian such returns accounts and other information as are specified therein and produce such documents as are so specified being returns accounts information and documents the furnishing or production of which the Custodian considers necessary for the discharge of his functions under this Order."
- 2. This Order may be cited as the Trading with the Enemy (Custodian) (Amendment) Order, 1948.
