The Minister of Health, in exercise of the power conferred on him by subsection (2) of section sixty-eight of the National Assistance Act, 11 & 12 1948, hereby makes the following order :--

Geo. 6. c. 29.

1. This Order may be cited as the National Assistance Act (Appointed Day) Order, 1948, and shall come into operation on the tenth day of June, 1948.

2. The National Assistance Act, 1948, except sections thirty-seven to forty thereof, shall, as respects England and Wales, come into operation on the fifth day of July nineteen hundred and forty-eight.

Given under the official seal of the Minister of Health this eighth day of June, nineteen hundred and forty-eight.
