The A50 Trunk Road (Blythe Bridge to Uttoxeter, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

 Made
 09 August 2010

 Coming into force
 16 August 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport being the traffic authority for the A50 Trunk Road ("the A50"), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road between Blythe Bridge and Uttoxeter in the County of Staffordshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A50 Trunk Road (Blythe Bridge to Uttoxeter, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 16 August 2010.

2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the westbound and eastbound carriageways of the

A50 from its roundabout junction with the A521, known as Tean Roundabout, east of Blythe Bridge, to its junction

with the A522 at Uttoxeter;

"the works period" means the period starting at 21.00 hours on Friday 20

August 2010 and ending when the said works have been

completed,

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
 - **5.** The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes,
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
