# **EDUCATION, ENGLAND**

## The New Woodlands School (Amendment) Order 2010

Made - - - - 2nd September 2010

Laid before Parliament 9th September 2010

Coming into force - - 30th September 2010

The Council of the London Borough of Lewisham ("the authority") and the governing body and head teacher (with the consent of the governing body) of New Woodlands School ("the School"), being qualifying bodies for the purposes of Chapter 1 of Part 1 of the Education Act 2002(a) ("the Act"), have, in accordance with section 4(2) of the Act, consulted such persons as required;

It is the opinion of the Secretary of State for Education pursuant to section 1(1)(a) of the Act, having regard to the matters set out in section 1(2), that the extension of the period for which the New Woodlands School Order 2007(b) ("the 2007 Order") has effect may contribute to the raising of educational standards in England;

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(1) and 3(1)(a)(iii) of the Act, on the application of the authority, and the governing body and head teacher of the School, makes the following Order(c):

#### Citation and commencement

**1.** This Order may be cited as the New Woodlands School (Amendment) Order 2010 and comes into force on 30th September 2010.

### **Amendment**

**2.** In article 8 of the 2007 Order (time period) for "30th September 2010" substitute "30th September 2013".
