**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The M6 Motorway (Junctions 33- 35, Northbound and  
Southbound Carriageways) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic)  
Order 2010**

*Made* - - - - - *26 August 2010*

*Coming into force* - - - - - *11 September 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M6 Motorway is satisfied that traffic on sections of that motorway in the City of Lancaster in the County of Lancashire should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M6 Motorway (Junctions 33-35, Northbound and Southbound Carriageways) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 11 September 2010.

2. In this Order:

“the motorway” means the M6 Motorway between Junctions 33 and 35;

“the first length of carriageway” means a section of the northbound carriageway of the motorway, from a point 1950 metres south of the centreline of the Kellet Road bridge, to a point 100 metres north of the centreline of Kellet Road bridge.

“the second length of carriageway” means a section of the southbound carriageway of the motorway, from a point 2450 metres north of the centreline of the Quernmore Road bridge, to a point 600 metres north of the centreline of Quernmore Road bridge.

“the first works period” means a period starting at 2000 hours on Sunday 12 September 2010 and ending at 0600 hours on Saturday 25 September 2010. However, works may start and continue beyond these dates, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

“the second works period” means a period starting at 2000 hours on Sunday 26 September 2010 and ending at 0600 hours on Saturday 9 October 2010. However, works may start and continue beyond these dates, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

“works” means safety fencing renewal works on the motorway.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 5 of this Order, during the first works period, no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to be driven in the first length of carriageway at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour.

**4.** Subject as mentioned in article 5 of this Order, during the second works period, no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to be driven in the second length of carriageway at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour.

**5.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance services or anything done at the direction of, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
