## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

## The A4 Trunk Road (Crowley Way, Avonmouth) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

Made	-	-	1 September 2010
Coming into force	-	-	4 September 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A4 Trunk Road ("the A4"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road between St Brendan's Roundabout and St Andrew's Roundabout in Avonmouth in the City of Bristol should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A4 Trunk Road (Crowley Way, Avonmouth) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 4 September 2010.

2. In this Order –

"the A4" means the westbound carriageway of the A4 Trunk Road (Crowley Way) in Avonmouth from the western edge of St Brendan's Roundabout to the eastern edge of the A403 St Andrew's Roundabout;

"the works" mean manhole repairs;

"a works period" means a period of 9 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Tuesday 7 September 2010 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A4.

**4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (c) a vehicle being used for or in connection with the works.
