## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The A3 Trunk Road (Eashing, Southbound) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

Made - - - - 13th September 2010

Coming into force - - 2nd October 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A3 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted and prohibited on a length of that road and on one of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A3 Trunk Road (Eashing, Southbound) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 2nd October 2010.

## 2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A3 Trunk Road south of Guildford in the County of Surrey;

"the southbound carriageway" means the southbound carriageway of the trunk road between points 445 metres south and 1400 metres south of the southbound entry slip road at Shackleford junction (Hurtmore Road);

"the slip road" means the road leading from the southbound carriageway of the trunk road to Eashing (Lower Eashing Road);

"works" mean carriageway maintenance and all associated work on the trunk road; and

- "a works period" means a period of 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 4th October 2010 or on any subsequent day until 1st April 2012.
- 3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 below, no person shall, during a works period -
  - (a) cause or permit any vehicle to overtake any other moving vehicle in the southbound carriageway; or
  - (b) cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.
- **4.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 below, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding
  - (a) 10 miles per hour on the southbound carriageway while traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating "convoy working" on that carriageway are displayed; or

- (b) 40 miles per hour on the southbound carriageway while the traffic signs specified in paragraph (a) of this article in relation to that carriageway are not displayed.
- **5.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
  - **6.** (1) Nothing in article 3 above shall apply to -
    - (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
    - (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
    - (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
    - (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
- (2) Nothing in article 4 above shall apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes.
