## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The A21 Trunk Road (Ebden's Hill) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

*Made - - - 13th September 2010* 

Coming into force - - 2nd October 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A21 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted and prohibited on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A21 Trunk Road (Ebden's Hill) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 2nd October 2010.

## 2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A21 Trunk Road near Hastings in the County of East Sussex;

"the length of trunk road" means both carriageways of the trunk road between points 120 metres north of its junction with the A28 (Westfield Lane/Maplehurst Road) and 280 metres south of that junction;

"the side road" means the A28 (Westfield Lane/Maplehurst Road) at its junction with the southbound carriageway of the trunk road at Ebden's Hill;

"works" mean resurfacing and all associated work on the trunk road; and

- "a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Monday 4th October 2010 or on any subsequent day until 1st April 2012.
- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter the side road from the trunk road or to enter the trunk road from the side road.
- **4.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 below, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on the length of trunk road while traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating "convoy working" on that length of road are displayed.
- **5.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- **6.** (1) Nothing in article 3 above shall apply to -
  - (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
  - (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
  - (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
  - (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
- (2) Nothing in article 4 above shall apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes.
