ROAD TRAFFIC

The A414 Trunk Road (A5183/A405 Watling Street Roundabout to M1 Motorway Junction 7 St Albans, Hertfordshire) Westbound (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

Made - - - - 13 September 2010

Coming into force - - 20 September 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A414 Trunk Road ("the A414), is satisfied that traffic on that road in the County of Hertfordshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the A414 Trunk Road (A5183/A405 Watling Street Roundabout to M1 Motorway Junction 7 St Albans, Hertfordshire) Westbound (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 20 September 2010.
- **2.** Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during a period of 9 hours starting at 21.00 hours on Monday 27 September 2010 or on any subsequent day (other than a Saturday or Sunday) until carriageway resurfacing, drainage works, bridge maintenance and road marking works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the westbound carriageway of A414 from of its junction with the A5183/A405 Watling Street Roundabout to its merge with the M1 Motorway at Junction 7, St Albans.
- **3.** The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or winter service maintenance purposes.
