## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

## The A50 Trunk Road (Hatton to Sudbury, Derbyshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A50 Trunk Road ("the A50") and connecting roads is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road and on one of those connecting roads between Hatton and Sudbury in the County of Derbyshire should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A50 Trunk Road (Hatton to Sudbury, Derbyshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 20 September 2010.

## **2.** In this Order:

"the first length of trunk road"	means the westbound carriageway of the A50 from a point 1000 metres east of its junction with the slip road leading to its roundabout junction with the A511, to that junction;
"the second length of trunk road"	means the westbound carriageway of the A50 from its junction with the slip road leading to its roundabout junction with the A511 near Hatton, to its roundabout junction with the A515 and Aston Lane at Sudbury;
"a slip road"	means the slip road leading to the westbound carriageway of the A50 from its roundabout junction with the A511;
"the works period"	means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Friday 24 September 2010 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the first length of trunk road.

**4.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the second length of trunk road or a slip road.

**5.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. The provisions of-

- (a) articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle
  - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes, or
  - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; and

(b) article 4 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
