ROAD TRAFFIC

The A66 Trunk Road (East Browson to Carkin Moor) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2010

Made - - - - - *13 September 2010*
Coming into force - - - - - *24 September 2010*

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A66 Trunk Road, in the District of Richmondshire in the County of North Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road should be restricted and prohibited because drainage and embankment repair works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A66 Trunk Road (East Browson to Carkin Moor) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 24 September 2010.

2. In this Order; –

“the A66” means the A66 Trunk Road from a point 15 metres east of the centreline of its junction with Dick Scot Lane (at East Browson) and a point 440 metres west of the centreline of its junction with Warrener Lane (at Hartforth Grange), a distance of 2760 metres;

“a layby” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b); and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in the A66 over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

“the works period” means a period of:

- (i) 18 hours starting at 16:00 hours on Saturday 25 September 2010 or any subsequent Saturday night thereafter until the said works have been completed;
- (ii) 10 hours commencing at 20:00 hours on Tuesday 28 September 2010 or any subsequent Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday night thereafter until the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the eastbound and westbound carriageways.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or wait in a layby situated adjacent to the A66 Trunk Road:

- (i) opposite Waitlands Lane (at West Layton); and
- (ii) approximately 250 metres east of Moor Lane Junction (at East Layton); or
- (iii) approximately 275 metres west of Moor Lane Junction (East Layton).

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs. Nothing in article 4 shall apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for winter maintenance or traffic officer purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer or traffic officer in uniform;

and nothing in article 3 shall apply to any vehicle being used for a purpose specified in paragraph (a) of this article.
