ROAD TRAFFIC

The M2 Motorway (Junction 1 – South of Junction 2) (Temporary Speed Restriction) Order 2010

Made - - - - 27th September 2010

Coming into force - - 16th October 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M2 Motorway, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted on a length of that motorway because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M2 Motorway (Junction 1 – South of Junction 2) (Temporary Speed Restriction) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 16th October 2010.

2. In this Order:

"the motorway" means the M2 Motorway near Rochester in the County of Kent;

"the length of coastbound carriageway" means the coastbound carriageway of the motorway from its junction with the A2 at Junction 1 (A289) to a point 200 metres south of Wouldham Road underbridge south of Junction 2 (A228);

"works" means bridge parapet work on the motorway; and

"the works period" means the period starting on Friday 22nd October 2010 and ending on 15th April 2012.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on length of coastbound carriageway.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes.
