ROAD TRAFFIC

The M42 Motorway (Junction 3) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

Made----23 September 2010Coming into force--30 September 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M42 Motorway ("the M42") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads at Junction 3 in the Counties of Warwickshire and Worcestershire should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The M42 Motorway (Junction 3) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 30 September 2010.

2. In this Order -

"the roundabout"	means the circulatory carriageway carrying the A435 over the M42 at Junction 3;
"a slip road"	means any slip road leading to or from the M42 at Junction 3.
"the works period"	means the period starting at 22.00 hours on Thursday 7 October 2010 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on the roundabout whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating "convoy working" on that roundabout are displayed.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- **6.** The provisions of:
 - (a) articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle -
 - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes, or
 - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; and
 - (b) article 4 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works or by a traffic officer in uniform.
