

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7 below, no person shall, during a second works period cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the second length of coastbound carriageway.

5. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7 below, no person shall, during a first works period, cause or permit any vehicle with an overall width exceeding 6 feet 6 inches to enter or proceed in the offside lane of the first length of coastbound carriageway.

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

7. (1) Nothing in articles 4 or 5 above shall apply to –

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.

(2) Nothing in article 5 above shall apply to an abnormal load.

(3) Nothing in article 3 above shall apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes.
