## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

## The A30 Trunk Road (Sourton Cross Junction, Near Okehampton) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A30 Trunk Road ("the A30") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads at the Sourton Cross Junction near Okehampton, in the District of West Devon in the County of Devon, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act  $1984(\mathbf{a})$ , hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A30 Trunk Road (Sourton Cross Junction, Near Okehampton) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 2 October 2010.

2. In this Order –

"the slip road" means the eastbound exit slip road at the A30 Sourton Cross Junction;

"the works" mean maintenance works;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 4 October 2010 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

**4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (c) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
