The A483 Trunk Road (Llynclys to South of Oswestry, Shropshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A483 Trunk Road ("the A483"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road near Llynclys in the County of Shropshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The A483 Trunk Road (Llynclys to South of Oswestry, Shropshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 11 October 2010.

2. In this Order:

"the trunk road"	means the northbound and southbound carriageways of the A483 between its junction with the A495 and B4396 at Llynclys and its roundabout junction with the A5 and B4579, south of Oswestry (Mile End Roundabout);
"the works period"	means the period starting at 21.00 hours on Monday 18 October 2010 and ending when the said works have been completed,

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes,
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable,
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works, or
- (iv) proceeding on the trunk road to or from premises which are accessible for that vehicle from and only from, that road.
