## ROAD TRAFFIC

The A12 Trunk Road (Yarmouth Road, Lowestoft, Suffolk) (Temporary 10 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) (No 2) Order 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A12 Trunk Road ("the A12"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road in the County of Suffolk should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the A12 Trunk Road (Yarmouth Road, Lowestoft, Suffolk) (Temporary 10 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) (No 2) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 18 October 2010.
- **2.** Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 25 October 2010 or on any subsequent day until the installation of a signal controlled crossing and associated equipment, footway works, road markings and high friction surfacing to the under mentioned length of A12 has been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on a length of the A12 Yarmouth Road Lowestoft between points 235 metres north and 320 metres south of the centre line of its junction with Gunton Church Lane, whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating "convoy working" on that length of road are displayed.
- **3.** The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes.
