ROAD TRAFFIC

The A46 Trunk Road and M5 Motorway (Junction 9) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

Made---8 October 2010Coming into force--15 October 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road ("the A46"), the M5 Motorway ("the M5) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of the A46 and three of those connecting roads near Tewkesbury in the County of Gloucestershire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road and M5 Motorway (Junction 9) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 15 October 2010.

2. In this Order:

"the roundabout"	means the circulatory carriageway of the A46 at M5 Junction 9;
"a slip road"	 means the slip road – (a) leading to and from the southbound carriageway of the M5 at Junction 9; and (b) leading to the northbound carriageway of the M5 at Junction 9;
"a pedal cycle"	has the meaning given in regulation 4 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b);
"the works period"	means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Wednesday 20 October 2010 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any person using a pedal cycle to enter or proceed in the cycle lane adjacent to the roundabout from a point 99 metres west of its junction with the slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the M5 at junction 9 to that junction.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works or by a traffic officer in uniform.
