## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The A259 Trunk Road (Icklesham) (Temporary 10 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2010

Made - - - - 18th October 2010

Coming into force - - 6th November 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A259 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A259 Trunk Road (Icklesham) (Temporary 10 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 6th November 2010.

## 2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A259 Trunk Road at Icklesham in the County of East Sussex;

"the length of trunk road" means the trunk road between points 30 metres east of Manor Close and 110 metres east of Oast House Road;

"works" mean the construction of a traffic crossing;

"a first works period" means a period of 6 hours starting at 0930 hours on Monday 8th November 2010 or on any subsequent day until 5th May 2012; and

"a second works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Monday 8th November 2010 or on any subsequent day until 5th May 2012.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5 below, no person shall, during a first works period or a second works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on the length of trunk road while traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating "convoy working" on that length of road are displayed.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- **5.** Nothing in article 3 above shall apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes.
