ROAD TRAFFIC

The A40 Trunk Road (Churcham, Near Gloucester) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2010

Made - - - - 27 October 2010

Coming into force - - 30 October 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A40 Trunk Road ("the A40"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road at Churcham in the District of Forest of Dean in the County of Gloucestershire should be prohibited and restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the A40 Trunk Road (Churcham, Near Gloucester) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 30 October 2010.

2. In this Order –

"the A40" means the A40 at Churcham from a point 100 metres west of the centre of its junction with Church Lane to a point 100 metres east of the centre of its junction with Bulley Lane;

"the works" mean works to provide a new culvert under the carriageway, associated drainage works, resurfacing and white lining;

"a works period" means a period of 9 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 1 November 2010 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to an article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour in the A40 whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating "convoy working" on that road are displayed.
- **4.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to overtake any other moving vehicle in the A40.
- **5.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:
 - (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes; or

- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.
- **6**. The provisions of article 4 shall not apply to:
- (a) a vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for traffic officer purposes.
