**The A14 Trunk Road (Junction 57 Nacton Interchange, Ipswich,
Suffolk) Westbound (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order
2010**

Made - - - - *1 November 2010*

Coming into force - - *8 November 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A14 Trunk Road (“the A14), is satisfied that traffic on that road in the County of Suffolk should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A14 Trunk Road (Junction 57 Nacton Interchange, Ipswich, Suffolk) Westbound (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 8 November 2010.
2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during a period of 7 hours starting at 22.00 hours on Thursday 11 November 2010 or on any subsequent day until traffic counter loop cutting works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the westbound carriageway of A14 between points 350 metres east and 300 metres west of the centre point of the A14/A1189 Nacton Interchange underbridge.
3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance, traffic officer or winter service maintenance purposes.
