The A5 Trunk Road (Flamstead, Hertfordshire) (Temporary 30 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road ("the A5"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road in the County of Hertfordshire should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act $1984(\mathbf{a})$, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Flamstead, Hertfordshire) (Temporary 30 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 8 November 2010.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during a period of –

- (a) 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 15 November 2010 or on any subsequent day (other than a Friday, Saturday or Sunday), or
- (b) 9 hours starting at 21.00 hours on Friday 19 November 2010 or on any subsequent Friday,

until drainage repairs, lighting repairs and barrier maintenance works have been completed, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the A5 between its junction with the Wootton Drive/Watery Lane Friars Wash Roundabout at Flamstead and a point 500 metres north of its junction with that roundabout.

3. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only during such times and such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes.
