ROAD TRAFFIC

The A66 Trunk Road (Cocker Bridge, Cockermouth) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2010

Made - - - - 4 November 2010

Coming into force - - 21 November 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A66 Trunk Road is satisfied that traffic on a section of that trunk road in the District of Allerdale in the County of Cumbria should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A66 Trunk Road (Cocker Bridge, Cockermouth) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 21 November 2010.

2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A66 Trunk Road;

"the length of carriageway" means a section of the trunk road from the point where the centre point of the trunk road meets the circulatory carriageway of the Lamplugh Roundabout (connecting the A5086 to the A66) to a point 675 metres east of the east face of the south pier of the Simonscales Bridge.

"the works period" means periods daily between 0930 hours and 1600 hours starting on Monday 22 November 2010 and ending on Sunday 19 December 2010. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent days or continue daily until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

"works" means the installation of an access platform at Cocker Bridge on the trunk road

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to be driven in the length of carriageway at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour.

4	1. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such
	extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle
	being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance
	services or anything done at the direction of, or with the permission, of a constable, or a
	traffic officer in uniform.
