ROAD TRAFFIC

The M3 Motorway (Junctions 14 – 4, Carriageways) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2010

Made - - - - 8th November 2010

Coming into force - - 30th November 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M3 Motorway, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted on a length of that motorway because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M3 Motorway (Junctions 14 - 4, Carriageways) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 30th November 2010 and shall apply for a period of twelve months.

2. In this Order:

"the motorway" means the M3 Motorway in the County of Hampshire;

"the Regulations" means the Motorways Traffic (England and Wales) Regulations 1982(b);

"a hard shoulder" means the hard shoulder, within the meaning of regulation 3(1)(e) of the Regulations, which is adjacent to a length of carriageway;

"a length of carriageway" means both carriageways of the motorway from its merge/diverge with the M27 at Junction 14 (M27 Junction 4) to Junction 4 (A331);

"works" mean essential carriageway repairs and associated works on the motorway; and

"a works period" means a period of -

- (i) 7 hours starting at 2200 hours on Tuesday 30th November 2010 or on any subsequent day other than a Friday, Saturday or Sunday,
- (ii) 7 hours starting at 2300 hours on Friday 3rd December 2010 or on any subsequent Friday,
- (iii) 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Saturday 4th December 2010 or on any subsequent Saturday, or
- (iv) 6½ hours starting at 2230 hours on Sunday 5th December 2010 or on any subsequent Sunday,

until 29th November 2011.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5 below, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on a length of carriageway or a hard shoulder.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes.
- **5.** During a works period, the provisions of regulations 5 and (insofar as it relates to a vehicle being driven) 9 of the Regulations are hereby suspended in respect of a hard shoulder, at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
