ROAD TRAFFIC

The A6 Trunk Road (Alvaston Bypass) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2010

Made - - - - 15 November 2010

Coming into force - - 22 November 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A6 Trunk Road ("the A6"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road at Alvaston in the City of Derby should be restricted because of the likelihood of danger to the public:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the A6 Trunk Road (Alvaston Bypass) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 22 November 2010.
- **2.** Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this order, no person shall, during the period starting at 00.01 hours on Wednesday 24 November 2010 and ending when the said likelihood of danger has been avoided by means other than this order, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on
 - (a) the northbound carriageway of the A6 between a point 1350 metres south east of the centreline of Green Lane footbridge and a point 85 metres east of the centreline of its roundabout junction with the A5111 (Raynesway Park Roundabout); and
 - (b) the southbound carriageway of the A6 between a point 85 metres east of the centreline of its roundabout junction with the A5111 (Raynesway Park Roundabout) and a point 570 metres south east of the centreline of Green Lane footbridge.
- **3.** The provisions of article 2 of this order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to any vehicle
 - (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
 - (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
