ROAD TRAFFIC

The A49 Trunk Road (Ludlow Bypass, Shropshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) (No. 2) Order 2010

Made - - - - 22 November 2010

Coming into force - - 29 November 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A49 Trunk Road (“the A49”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road at Ludlow in the County of Shropshire should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The A49 Trunk Road (Ludlow Bypass, Shropshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) (No. 2) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 29 November 2010.

2. In this Order –

“the first length trunk road” means the northbound carriageway of the A49 from its junction with the B4365 to the centre line of the River Corve Bridge;

“the second length trunk road” means the northbound carriageway of the A49 from its junction with the B4361 to the centre line of the B4361 underbridge;

"the works period" means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Monday 6 December 2010 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding –

(a) (a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1

- (a) 40 miles per hour on the first length of trunk road; and
- (b) 10 miles per hour on a length of the second length of trunk road whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that length of road are displayed.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter the northbound carriageway of the A49 from the B4361 Bromfield Road.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. The provisions of:

- (a) articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle -
 - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes, or
 - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; and
- (b) article 4 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
