ROAD TRAFFIC

The M4 Motorway (Junction 17 Eastbound Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

Made - - - - 23 November 2010

Coming into force - - 29 November 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M4 Motorway ("the M4") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on two of those connecting roads at Junction 17 in Wiltshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M4 Motorway (Junction 17 Eastbound Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 29 November 2010.

2. In this Order -

"the slip roads" mean (i) the eastbound entry slip road at M4 Junction 17; and (ii) the eastbound exit slip road at M4 Junction 17;

"the works" mean carriageway patching works across the mouth of the eastbound entry and exit slip roads at M4 Junction 17;

"a works period" means a period of 9 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Wednesday 1 December 2010 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip roads.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:
 - (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
 - (c) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works or for winter maintenance purposes.
