## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The A259 Trunk Road (Folkestone Road, East Guldeford) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2010

Made - - - - 20th December 2010

Coming into force - - 8th January 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A259 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A259 Trunk Road (Folkestone Road, East Guldeford) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 8th January 2011.

## 2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A259 Trunk Road at East Guldeford in the County of East Sussex;

"the length of trunk road" means the trunk road (Folkestone Road) between points 30 metres east and 30 metres west of Star Level Crossing;

"works" means level crossing maintenance work on the trunk road; and

"a works period" means a period of 27 hours starting at 0100 hours on Sunday 16th January 2011 or on any subsequent Sunday until 3rd April 2011.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of trunk road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -
  - (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
  - (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
  - (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform:
  - (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes; or
  - (e) a vehicle proceeding in the length of trunk road to or from premises accessible from, and only from, that road to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs.
