**The M61 Motorway (Junction 6 Southbound Exit
Slip Road)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010**

Made - - - - 22 December 2010

Coming into force - - 9 January 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M61 Motorway and slip roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those slip roads in the Borough of Bolton in Greater Manchester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the M61 Motorway (Junction 6 Southbound Exit Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 9 January 2011.

2. In this Order;

“the motorway” means the M61 Motorway;

“works” means barrier installation and replacement traffic sign works on the slip road;

“the works period” means twenty one nights between 2200 hours and 0500 hours Monday to Friday, and between 2200 hours and 0700 hours Saturday to Sunday during a period starting on Monday 10 January 2011 and ending on Monday 31 January 2011. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue overnight until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

“the slip road” means the exit slip road leading from the southbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 6.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
