ROAD TRAFFIC

The A1 Trunk Road (Near Grantham, Lincolnshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

Made - - - - 29 December 2010

Coming into force - - 5 January 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1 Trunk Road (“the A1”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road and one of those connecting roads near Grantham in the County of Lincolnshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A1 Trunk Road (Near Grantham, Lincolnshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 5 January 2011.

2. In this Order –

“the trunk road” means the northbound carriageway of the A1 from its junction with the exit slip road leading to the A52 at Barrowby, to its junction with the slip road leading from its roundabout junction with the B1174 at Gonerby Moor;

“the slip road” means the slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the A1 from the A52 at Barrowby;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Tuesday 11 January 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
