## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The A49 Trunk Road (Victoria Street, Hereford) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

*Made - - - - 31 December 2010* 

Coming into force - - 7 January 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport being the traffic authority for the A49 Trunk Road ("the A49") is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, at Hereford in the District of the County of Herefordshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A49 Trunk Road (Victoria Street, Hereford) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 7 January 2011.

## **2.** In this Order:

"the works period"

means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 10 January 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to make a right turn from the southbound carriageway of the A49 Victoria Street into Eign Street.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
  - 5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle-
    - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes,

(ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or
(iii) being used in connection with the said works.
