## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

## The A417 and A419 Trunk Roads (Cirencester) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made -	-	-	-	29th March 2011
Coming into	force	-	-	2nd April 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A417 Trunk Road ("the A417") and the A419 Trunk Road ("the A419") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads near Cirencester in the County of Gloucestershire and in Wiltshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(**a**), hereby makes the following Order:

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A417 and A419 Trunk Roads (Cirencester) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 2nd April 2011.

2. In this Order -

"the slip roads" mean (i) the A417 southbound entry slip road at the Burford Road Junction, Cirencester; (ii) the A419 southbound entry slip road at the Driffield Junction; (iii) the A419 southbound entry and exit slip roads at the South Cerney Junction; (iv) the A419 northbound entry and exit slip roads at the South Cerney Junction; (v) the A419 northbound exit slip road at the Driffield Junction; and (vi) the A417 northbound exit slip road at the Burford Road Junction, Cirencester;

"the works" mean concrete joint maintenance works;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Tuesday 5th April 2011 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip roads.

**4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to:

(a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;

- (b) a vehicle being used at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable or traffic officer in uniform.
- (c) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
